Boarding Policy**

Thank you for allowing us to care for your pet(s) during your absence. For the protection of your pet(s), as well as others staying with us, **we require that all pets be current on vaccinations and free of external parasites** (i.e., fleas, ticks). We do require written verification of vaccinations if done elsewhere.

All animals will be admitted and released during business hours only. Our hours are: Monday through Friday 7:30am to 6:00pm, and Saturday 8:00am to 12:00pm. Your pet(s) will be taken care of twice a day on weekends and holidays. **Pets cannot be admitted or released after business hours.**

Please provide us with any medication, instructions, special attention, or diet information that your pet(s) may require while staying with us. We strive to keep your pets in a clean, safe, healthy environment and provide plenty of attention and care.

The Clinic is not responsible for any items (bed, blanket, towels, toys, etc...) that you leave with your pet if the animal soils, tears, or destroys items or if they are lost. If you choose to leave an item with your pet, it is your responsibility to mark each item permanently with your last name and your pet's name. We provide everything your pet needs while they are staying with us including bowls, towels, blankets, bedding, toys, Science Diet food, and water. **We do our best to insure your pet is happy while being away from home.**

**Alsbury Animal Hospital reserves the right to provide necessary medical care while your pet(s) is boarding.**

**Vaccinations Required:** Dogs: Rabies, DHP-PV-CV & Lepto and Bordetella  
Cats: Rabies, FVRCP, FELV (if outside cat)

*\*We recommend that a heartworm test be done yearly on all dogs. Your pet also needs a complete exam every year, which is required when vaccinations are given.*

*\*We recommend that the Bordetella vaccine be given 2 weeks prior to boarding to help reduce the risk of your dog getting kennel cough. The Bordetella vaccine is NOT 100% effective. Therefore, if your dog gets kennel cough while boarding with us, we will send the appropriate medication at the owner's expense.*

**Fecal:** We **require** that all dogs have a fecal check within the past year to board so that intestinal parasites are not spread to other patients that are staying at the clinic. We recommend that a fecal check be done yearly on cats.

**Parasite Control:** If your pet has external parasites (i.e., fleas, ticks), they will be treated accordingly at your expense.

**Boarding Charges:** Please call the clinic for pricing and availability.

Your pet may not eat as much here as he/she does at home, and can sometimes have an upset tummy or loose stool due to the stress of being away from home. After your pet goes home, he/she may be more sleepy due to all the excitement of seeing other animals and being in a different environment. We will do everything we can to keep your pet comfortable while he/she is staying with us.
